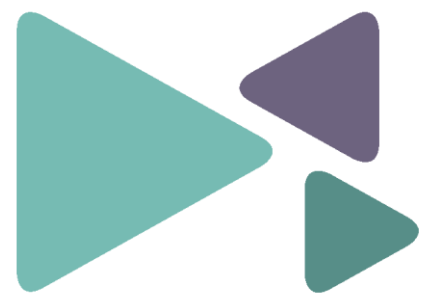

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Enhanced DBS check guidance

What is an Enhanced DBS Check?

An Enhanced DBS check is for roles 'exempt' from the Rehabilitation of Offenders Act and included in the Police Act Regulations.

For example, roles working with children or adults in certain circumstances such as those in receipt of healthcare or personal care.

The role may also be eligible for a DBS Barred list.

What does an Enhanced DBS Check cover?

An Enhanced DBS check details all convictions and cautions held on the Police National Computer (PNC) and previously stepped down cautions/convictions, unless they are now [filtered](#).

The certificates will not distinguish between convictions which are spent and those which are unspent.

Cautions and convictions that are filtered by the DBS will not be disclosed.

Who is eligible for an Enhanced DBS Check?

This is generally determined by the setting that the applicant is working in e.g schools, care homes or children's hospitals.


Other roles that are entitled to this are;

- Individuals who work in a high security psychiatric hospital
- Individuals applying to register as a social care worker
- Individuals applying as part of registration as a childminder agency, managing a childminder agency or working for a childminder agency in a quality assurance role visiting day care or childminding premises.

How do you apply for an Enhanced DBS Check?


An individual cannot apply for an Enhanced DBS Check themselves, this must be applied for by the organisation the individual is working for.

If registered with Disclosure Services, the employer would need to log in to their online portal and select 'Enhanced' from the Application Level options.
